As well as helping music fans locate the festivals, users of the nüvi 700 and 205 series will be able to make use of Garmin's simple 'park position recall' function which saves their last position automatically and enables them to find their way back to the car again once the music's finished.

And just in case of an emergency, Garmin's 'Where Am I?' brings peace of mind on any journey. Tap the car icon for directions to the nearest hospital, police or petrol station and details of your exact location, nearest address and junction.

Garmin sat-navs are packed with up to millions of points of interest. Personalise your device with custom POIs for places you like to go – perhaps your favourite chain of coffee houses or pizza restaurants

If you're using Garmin Mobile XT, it features a Location Based Messaging service (LMS) which is perfect for the hectic festival environment. Mobile XT provides a simple plug-and-play navigation function for GPS-enabled smartphones, whilst LMS enables friends to find each other by sending an SMS of their current location to others with MobileXT on their phone – ideal if one of you is at the bar and trying to find your way back to your friends who are near the stage.
