SUBJECT: TAWS/Terrain alerts near Stags of Broadhaven, Ireland

## **DESCRIPTION**

Terrain Database Cycle 16T1 and previously released versions do not accurately represent some elevations at the Stags of Broadhaven, Ireland, located at N54° 22', W009° 47'. As a result, this location will not trigger TAWS/Terrain alerts under the appropriate conditions and its elevations will not be depicted accurately by Synthetic Vision Technology (SVT).

Nearest airports to the affected region:

- EIBT (12 nm)
- EISG (42 nm)
- EIKN (44 nm)



## **PILOT ACTION**

Pilots should use extra caution and maintain awareness of the surrounding terrain when flying near the Stags of Broadhaven.
